Alice S. Apple, also known as Jerry's "Queen Bee", age 82, of Jasper, Indiana, passed away at 4:50 p.m. on Sunday, November 1, 2020, in Deaconess Gateway Medical Center in Evansville, Indiana.

Alice was born in Louisville, Kentucky, on February 16, 1938, to Eugene and Sara Mae (Keating) Arnold. She married Gerald "Jerry" Apple on November 28, 1993, in Jasper, Indiana.

She was a 1956 graduate of Mercy Academy. She then attended the Sisters of Mercy convent in Cincinnati, Ohio.

She worked as a manager at Burger Chef and Hardees restaurant in Washington and Jasper, Indiana, for 30 years, and then retired from the Schnitzelbank Restaurant in Jasper, Indiana, where she had worked for 11 years. She was also the former owner of the Red Barn restaurant in Washington, Indiana.

Alice was a member of St. Joseph's Catholic Church in Jasper, Indiana, where she was a Eucharistic minister, St. Ann's Society, Jasper D of I, AARP, where she was vice president, the Historical Society of the Dubois County Museum
