He was born at Henryville, Indiana on August 6, 1925 to Frederick and Elizabeth (Sehr) Schuler. He married Rosina Menonna on August 21, 1954 in St. Joan of Arch Catholic Church, Indianapolis, Indiana. Al Schuler was a WWII Navy Veteran and retired teacher for the Greater Jasper School system for 38 years. He also taught at Vincennes University Jasper Campus. He received his Agriculture Science Degree from Purdue University in 1950 and later his Master Degree. He is a member of St. Joseph Catholic Church where he served as a usher.
