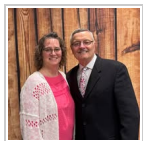
“ *We are so sad to hear that Uncle Brosie has passed away. He was such a great man. We will only have happy memories of him for all the rest of our lives.*

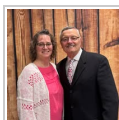
