Ambrose A. Pfister, age 98 of Jasper, Indiana, passed away at 11:36 p.m. on Monday (August 22, 2016) at St. Charles Health Campus in Jasper, Indiana.

Ambrose was born on July 20, 1918 in Jasper, Indiana to Amos and Elizabeth (Streicher) Pfister. He married Mildred Fritch on December 6, 1945 in St. Joseph Catholic Church. She preceded him in death on November 20, 2000.

Ambrose retired from Kimball, Jasper Laminates after 28 years of service.
