Ardella I. Schneider, age 92, of St. Anthony, Indiana, passed away at 9:46 a.m. on Monday (September 12, 2016) at Memorial Hospital and Health Care Center in Jasper.

Ardella was born in St. Anthony, Indiana on May 12, 1924, to Hubert and Pauline (Altmeyer) Persohn.

She married Clarence "Pete" Schneider on July 21, 1943 in St. Anthony Catholic Church. He preceded her in death on March 23, 2016 after 72 years of marriage.

Ardella worked at the Jasper Hatchery during World War II, was a cook at the Schnitzelbank and the St. Meinrad Abbey. She also babysat for children in the neighborhood.

She was a member of Divine Mercy Parish - St. Anthony Catholic Church, the St. Anthony American Legion Post 493 Auxiliary, the Christian Mothers, and was an avid member and collector of the Salt and Pepper Shakers Club.
