



## Arnold J. "Arnie" Mehringer

May 11, 1941 - July 26, 2023

Arnold J. "Arnie" Mehringer, age 82 of Jasper, Indiana, passed away at 11:12 pm on Wednesday, July 26, 2023 at St. Charles Health Campus in Jasper, Indiana.

Arnie was born in Evansville, Indiana on May 11, 1941 to Alphonse and Frances (Thewes) Mehringer. After Alphonse passed when Arnie was ten, he was raised by his mother and step father Ray Jochum. He married Lucille Durcholz on October 10, 1964 in Precious Blood Catholic Church.

He served in the Indiana Army National Guard.

Arnie retired from Jasper Lumber after many years in the woodworking industry. He also farmed part time his entire life.

He was a member of St. Joseph Catholic Church in Jasper. He was active in the 4-H, where he was a member of the Sheep Committee. Arnie was a member of Jasper Outdoor Recreation and enjoyed being a volunteer and tour guide for the Dubois County Museum.
