Bernadine H. Schnell, age 91 of Jasper, Indiana, passed away at 6:50 p.m. on Saturday, November 23, 2019 at Memorial Hospital and Health Care Center in Jasper, Indiana.

Bernadine was born on March 3, 1928 in Jasper, Indiana to Edward and Catherine (Kluemper) Hopf. She married Hilbert H. Schnell on May 7, 1949 in St. Joseph Catholic Church in Jasper. He preceded her in death on April 5, 2015.

She graduated Salutatorian from the one room Breitweiser School near Dubois.

She was a homemaker but in her younger years she worked for Kenrads in Huntingburg making electrical tubes for radios and radar systems, and also worked for Jasper Wood Products where she made parts for aircraft glider wing, both for the war effort.

Bernadine was a member of Holy Family Catholic Church in Jasper and their Blessed Virgin Sodality. She enjoyed embroidering for the Holy Family quilts, baking for church events, and participating in the Holy Family grandparent

program.

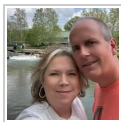
