Beulah C. Gramelspacher, age 86 of Jasper, Indiana, passed away at 2:55 a.m. on Friday, March 13, 2020 at home.

Beulah was born in Corning, Indiana on September 30, 1933 to Michael L. and Mary E. (Grannan) Doyle. She married John "Jack" Gramelspacher on October 24, 1953 in St. Patrick's Catholic Church in Corning, IN. He preceded her in death on January 7, 2010.

She had worked in admissions at Memorial Hospital in Jasper, as a receptionist for Drs. Ploetner, Beaven, and Kemker, and then retired as an activities coordinator at the Providence Home in Jasper.
