Bret A. Horne, age 59, of Jasper, Indiana, passed away on Saturday, March 16, 2019, at St. Vincent's Hospital in Evansville, Indiana.

Bret was born in Jasper, Indiana, on November 4, 1959, to Lee "Toot" and Perline (Vogler) Horney. He married Sun Kwai Ying, who is lovingly referred to as Amy.

He was a 1978 graduate of Jasper High School.

For the last 20 years, Bret resided in the state of New York, working as a manufacturer's representative, but he always considered Jasper, Indiana, as his home.

He is survived by his wife, Sun Kwai "Amy" Ying, Jasper, IN, his parents, Toot and Perline Horney, Jasper, IN, one sister Kim (Patrick) Lottes, and two brothers, Scott (Cindy) Horney, and Mike (Diann) Horney, all of Jasper, IN, and three step-children, James, Jack, and Tony DiTuro, whom he looked upon as his own.

Bret was known as the uncle who liked to tease them, but his nieces and
