Cecilia M. "C. Mae" Ploetner, age 93 of Jasper, Indiana, passed away at 8:03 p.m. on Wednesday, March 7, 2018 at St. Charles Health Campus in Jasper, Indiana.

C. Mae was born in Jasper, Indiana on May 1, 1924 to Henry and Cecilia (Reyling) Kress. She married Dr. Edward Ploetner on May 16, 1946 in St. Joseph Catholic Church. He preceded her in death on December 21, 2004.

She was a 1942 graduate of the Ferdinand Academy of Immaculate Conception, and continued her education at the Nazareth School of Nursing in Louisville, KY.

C. Mae worked as a registered nurse at St. Joseph's Infirmary in Louisville, KY in her earlier years, and then was a homemaker.

She was a member of St. Joseph Catholic Church and their St. Ann's Society. She was also a member of the Jasper Circle of the Daughters of Isabella, and the Memorial Hospital Auxiliary.

She enjoyed golfing, bowling, and playing bridge and bingo, she also enjoyed
