Clarence E. Schroeder, age 95, of Jasper, Indiana, passed away at 8:50 a.m. on Tuesday, April 27, 2021, in Memorial Hospital and Health Care Center in Jasper, Indiana.

Clarence was born in Jasper, Indiana, on November 24, 1925, to August and Catherine (Streicher) Schroeder. He married Virginia "Jeanie" Bartley on October 19, 1948, in St. Joseph's Catholic Church in Jasper, Indiana. She preceded him in death on April 26, 2017.

He was a construction engineer for the Engineering Corps in the United States Army, serving during WWII in both the European Theatre and the Pacific.

Clarence retired from JOFCO.

He was a founding and lifetime member of Precious Blood Catholic Church in Jasper, Indiana, and V.F.W. Post #673.
