Dr. Daniel J. Berger, age 89 of Jasper, Indiana, passed away at 7:50 p.m. on Wednesday (December 16, 2015) at St. Charles Health Campus in Jasper, Indiana.

Daniel was born on July 14, 1926 in St. Meinrad, Indiana to Joseph and Verena (Ruxer) Berger. He married Jackie Stewart on June 9, 1951 in St. Louis, MO.

Daniel was a dentist who practiced in Jasper for over 48 years. He was a member of the American Dental Association, Indiana Dental Association, The First District Dental Society, the Academy of General Dentistry, and a fellow in the American College of Dentists. He served on the State Board of Dental Examiners for nine years.

He was an Army Air Corp Veteran who served in WWII, and a was a member of the American Legion Post #147 in Jasper.

He was awarded the Sagamore of the Wabash in 1988.

Knights of Columbus 4th Degree Knight.
