David L. Sternberg, age 67, of Jasper, Indiana, passed away on the morning of Saturday, July 15, 2023, at home surrounded by family.

Dave was born in Jasper, Indiana, on July 20, 1955, to Oscar and Viola (Hochgesang) Sternberg. He married Kathy Merkel on May 5, 1984, in Holy Family Catholic Church in Jasper, Indiana.

He was a 1973 graduate of Jasper High School. He then, for a combined four years, attended school and completed an apprenticeship to become an electrical lineman.

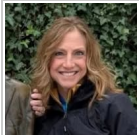
