Dennis E. Schroering, age 87 of Jasper, IN, passed away at 2:13 p.m. on Tuesday, December 4, 2018 at Brookside Village in Jasper, IN.

Dennis was born on March 1, 1931 in Jasper, Indiana to Frank and Mary (Beckman) Schroering. He married Joan Sander on August 24, 1957 at St. Raphael Catholic Church in Dubois, IN.

He was a U.S. Air Force Veteran who served in the Korean War, and a life member of the VFW Post #673 in Jasper.

He was a lifelong Farmer.

Dennis was a member of Holy Family Catholic Church in Jasper, a member of the Holy Family CRHP group, a recipient of the Brute Award, and a member of the Jasper Knights of Columbus, and St. Vincent De Paul.
