Donald L. "Dutch" Stenftenagel, age 86, passed away at 12:40 p.m. on Thursday, March 5, 2020, at the Northwood Retirement Community in Jasper, Indiana.

Dutch was born in Jasper, Indiana, on October 8, 1933, to Edward and Gertrude (Neuhoff) Stenftenagel.

He was a graduate of Jasper High School.

He was a United States Army Veteran, serving in the 164th Infantry from 1953-1955.

Dutch retired from Kimball, where he had worked as a truck driver and fork lift operator for several years.

He attended St. Joseph's Catholic Church in Jasper, Indiana, and was a member of American Legion Post #147, V.F.W. Post #673, and the Jasper Moose.

Surviving are three daughters, Sharon (Ken) Hurst, Kim (Mark) Zehr, Micki
