



## Dorothy E. "Dottie" Keller

October 11, 1935 - January 20, 2022

Dorothy E. "Dottie" Keller, age 86 of Jasper, Indiana, passed away at 7:47 pm on Thursday, January 20, 2022, at Cathedral Health Care Center in Jasper, Indiana.

Dottie was born in Huntingburg, Indiana on October 11, 1935 to Ernest and Frances (Sollman) Rademacher. She married Kenneth Keller on April 28, 1956 in Fort Riley Kansas. He preceded her in death on June 18, 2014.

Dottie retired from Memorial Hospital in Jasper, where she worked as a Certified Nursing Assistant for twenty years.
