Dorothy M. Weidenbenner, age 91, passed away peacefully on Friday, September 15, 2023, at St. Charles Health Campus in Jasper, Indiana.

Dorothy was born on July 3, 1932, to William and Rose (Prechtel) Teder. She was the youngest of seven children and raised on the farm in Celestine, Indiana. She married Bernie Weidenbenner on November 28, 1957, in St. Joseph Catholic Church and recently celebrated their 65th wedding anniversary.

Dorothy was a District Sales Manager for Avon Products for 31 years, managing over 200 sales representatives in 18 counties in southern Indiana. Her district was in the Circle of Excellence (Top 5%) and won trips to Rome, Hawaii, Canada, Mexico, & the Bahamas.
