He was born in Huntingburg, Indiana July 26, 1942 to Gilbert E. and Mary Jane (King) Metzger. He married Sylvia Schneider on April 4, 1964 in St. Joseph Catholic Church. Earl Metzger owned and was general manager of WITZ and WQKZ Radio Stations and also previously WITY Radio Station in Danville, Illinois. He was also part -owner and president of the Holiday Liquors Store chain. Earl was a member of the Jasper High School Class of 1960, graduated from the Kentucky School of Mortuary Science and attended Bellarmine College in Louisville, Kentucky He served on the Board of Vincennes University, Jasper Center and the board of the First United Federal Savings Bank, and served on the advisory board of the Permanent Federal Savings Bank.

Member of the Indiana Broadcasters Hall of Fame of which he served as President of the Broadcasters Pioneers. As a member of the IBA, he had served on the board as Secretary/Treasurer, President elect and President. He was instrumental in formation of the IBA State-Wide Radio Network. He was involved in organizing the Junior Achievement Program in Jasper serving as its Vice President and President as well as heading many of it fund drives. Also served as past secretary of the Jasper Lions Club.

He was a member of St. Joseph Catholic Church where he had taught religious education; he also broadcasted Midnight Mass from St. Joseph's Church.. Jasper Knight of Columbus, Jasper Lions Club, Jasper Chamber of Commerce.
