Dr. Edith "Edie" C. Johnson, age 79, of Jasper, Indiana, passed away at 5:03 p.m. on Sunday, January 24, 2021, at Memorial Hospital and Health Care Center in Jasper, Indiana.

Edith was born on October 7, 1941, in Queens Village, New York, to Arthur and Ruth (Moe) Gronberg. Edie married Rev. Edward A. Johnson on August 8, 1981, he preceded her in death on December 6, 1996.

She earned a B.A. in Bible, M.A. in Theology, and a Doctor's degree in Theology.

She was active with Women of the Evangelical Lutheran Church, served 10 years on the Indiana-Kentucky Synodical Board, ending as president for four years.
