November 3, 1937 - March 21, 2017

Eugene M. Gehlhausen, age 79, of Jasper, Indiana, passed away at 10:21 a.m. on Tuesday, March 21, 2017 at Memorial Hospital and Health Care Center in Jasper, Indiana.

Eugene was born in Ferdinand, Indiana, on November 3, 1937 to Jerome "Harry" and Charlotte (Reutman) Gehlhausen. He married Barbara Vonderheide on November 15, 1958, in Holy Family Catholic Church in Jasper, Indiana. She preceded him in death on February 11, 2015.

Eugene was a U.S. Army Veteran. He retired from Indiana Desk/IFI as a cabinet maker after 40 years, spent many years building and remodeling homes in the area, and had also worked part time at St. Joseph's Catholic Church in Jasper.

He was a member of Holy Family Catholic Church in Jasper, St. Anthony American Legion Post #493 and its military funeral detail, and the Jasper Knights of Columbus.

He was a master carpenter and enjoyed gardening, working outdoors, playing cards, and spending time with grandchildren and family.

Surviving are two daughters, Annette (Brian) Tuell and Lori (Brennan)

Schepers, and two sons, Scott (Debbie) Gehlhausen and Patrick (Jane) Gehlhausen, all of Jasper, 8 grandchildren, 4 great-grandchildren, two sisters, Mary Schulte, Jasper, IN, and Rosie Vitiello, Louisville, KY and two sister-in-laws, Doris Gehlhausen, Jasper, IN, and Sylvia Gehlhausen, Evansville, IN.

Preceding him in death besides his wife are three sisters, Harriet Fischer, Charlotte "Butsy" Klueh, and Eugenia "Dolly" Durcholz, and three brothers, Jerome, Charlie, and Herb Gehlhausen.
