Eugene A. "Gene" Haase, age 92, of Ireland, Indiana, passed away at 2:55 p.m. on Thursday, May 7, 2020, in St. Charles Health Campus in Jasper, Indiana.

Gene was born in Fornfelt, Missouri, on April 3, 1928, to Albert and Alvina (Blattel) Haase. He married Barbara Schmitt on June 10, 1954, in St. Mary's Catholic Church in Ireland, Indiana. She preceded him in death on November 18, 1994.

Gene was a graduate of Jasper High School.

He was a United States Army Veteran, serving two years during the Korean War.

Gene worked for Fromme Electric for nine years and then retired from the city of Jasper, where he had worked for 36 years.

He was a member of St. Mary's Catholic Church in Ireland, Jasper K of C, Ireland Sportsman Club, and V.F.W. #673.

He was an avid card player, enjoying Sheephead. He also enjoyed playing horseshoes, and watching sports, especially the St. Louis Cardinals and Indiana University.
