Frieda W. Bellner Messmer, age 91, of Jasper, Indiana, passed away peacefully in the presence of family at 4:53 a.m. on Thursday, July 23, 2020, at Northwood Retirement Community in Jasper, Indiana.

Frieda was born in Celestine, Indiana, on April 13, 1929, to Basil and Frances (Schnell) Welp. She had two marriages. Her first marriage was to Daniel E. Bellner on October 16, 1948. He preceded her in death on March 25, 1991. Her second marriage was to Peter Messmer on September 20, 1997. He preceded her in death on November 5, 2010.

She was a member of St. Joseph's Catholic Church, the D of I, St. Anne's Society, VFW Auxiliary, and the Alpha Grandmothers Club.

In her younger years she was employed by General Electric and Beck's Restaurant. Later, she became a waitress at the Holiday Inn and was an Avon sales representative for over 37 years. She was a vendor at the Huntingburg and Jasper Farmer's Markets where she sold her homemade jellies and vegetables.

She was an avid gardener and well known for her blackberries. She enjoyed

traveling, playing cards, and spending time with her family.
