Gary A. Hasenour, age 73, of Celestine, Indiana, passed away at 6:38 p.m. on Tuesday, February 3, 2026, at Deaconess Memorial Medical Center in Jasper, Indiana.

Gary was born in Jasper, Indiana, on September 22, 1952, to Victor and Mae (Striegel) Hasenour. He married Dolores Mehling on June 25, 1977, in St. Ferdinand Church.

He was a 1970 Jasper High School graduate.

In his earlier years, he drove truck with his dad and brother at Central Concrete. In the 1970s, he began working in construction where he worked union for Kluesner Masonry. Some of his projects included the Eastland Mall and St. Marys Hospital in Evansville. He was project manager at St. Meinrad Seminary for their renovation in the early 1980s. He received the Celestine Distinguished Service Award and the Simon Brute Award.

He enjoyed working, and anyone that worked with Gary knew that you better work hard. He made you work to your full potential. His favorite saying was, "How many hands do you have?" He loved hunting, fishing, and spending time with his family, grandchildren, and friends.
