Harold Lee Hoffman "Lee", age 71 of Crystal, Indiana, passed away at 12:49 a.m. on Saturday, February 24, 2018 at Memorial Hospital and Healthcare Center in Jasper.

Lee was born in Brazil, Indiana on October 22, 1946 to Harold Wayne and Betty (Knust) Hoffman.

Lee owned and operated Hoffman Auto Supply in Rockport, IN and Owensboro, KY for many years, and earlier in his career was a teacher at Heritage Hills High School.

Lee graduated from Brazil High School and from Indiana State University with a bachelor's degree in teaching. He was a Freemason with the Gentryville No. 424 Indiana Freemasons and also was a member of Hadi Shrine.

For over 30 years, Lee's life passion was dirt track racing with several track championships and one of the most successful racing careers in the tri-state area.
