Harold Lee Wright, age 78, of Jasper, Indiana, passed away surrounded by family at 8:40 p.m. on Tuesday, August 6, 2024, at St. Charles Health Campus in Jasper, Indiana.

Harold was born in Paoli, Indiana, on November 8, 1945, to Wayne and Theda (McDonald) Wright. He married Eileen Laake on August 29, 1970, at St. Ferdinand Catholic Church in Ferdinand, Indiana.

He was a 1963 graduate of Jasper High School.

Harold was a United States Army Veteran, who served in Germany from 1966-1968.
