Harvey H. Dilger, age 79 of Jasper, Indiana, passed away peacefully at 1:02 a.m. on Saturday, August 19, 2017 at St. Charles Health Campus in Jasper, Indiana.

Harvey was born in Mariah Hill, Indiana on August 11, 1938 to Richard F. and Gertrude (Bettag) Dilger. He married Betty L. Wuebkenberg on September 9, 1961 in St. Joseph Catholic Church in Dale.

Harvey retired from Kimball International after 45 years of service. He was also a self-employed painter.
