She was born in Ireland, Indiana, on September 6, 1916 to John O. and Cecilia (Bueltel) Heim. She married Roy W. Allen on February 11, 1939 at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Ireland, IN. He preceded her in death on February 28, 1993. Henrietta was an elementary school teacher who taught for 28 years. She began her teaching career in a one room schoolhouse in 1936 at New Antioch Schoolhouse in Madison township. She taught the rest of her career within Dubois County, most of those in Ireland, IN. She was a member of St. Mary's Catholic Church of Ireland, the St. Ann's Society, and the Daughters of Isabella. She was a graduate of the Ireland High School Class of 1934. She graduated from Indiana University and also attended Oakland City University. She was a member of the Dubois County Retired Teachers Association and the Ireland Historical Society.
