He was born at Dubois, Indiana on November 20, 1933 to Elmer and Cecelia (Arnold) Zehr. He graduated from Dubois High School in 1951. After graduating from high school, he joined the United States Air Force and served his country from 1952-1956. In 1956 he enrolled at Indiana University and began studying for his degree in secondary education. He received a B.S. degree in 1960, and an M.S. degree in 1962 with a certification to teach math and science. His teaching career at Jasper High School began in 1960 and lasted until his retirement in 1994. For 34 years Herschel taught algebra, geometry, and Senior Math to the students of Jasper High School. Herschel Zehr is a life-long learner, and in his retirement he continues his education as an avid reader.
