July 19, 1943 - May 14, 2020

Hugh T. "Sonny" Mattingly, Jr., Jasper, passed away at 4:05am on Thursday, May 14, 2020 at home after a six year battle with Chronic Lymphocytic Leukemia.

Hugh was born in Washington, IN on July 19, 1943 to Hugh and Eleanor (McLemore) Mattingly. He married Donna M. Eisenhut on July 16, 1966 at St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Haysville, IN.

Hugh graduated from Jasper High School in 1961. He earned a degree in Business Administration from Vincennes University Jasper Center. He was one of the first two graduates from VUJC, in 1972, and later went on to serve as an instructor of Labor Economics at the University. He served in the Indiana National Guard and is a graduate of the Indiana Military Academy.

He took great pride in spending his entire 40 year working career with Kimball International, Electronics Division. He was active in his church, Trinity United Church of Christ, having volunteered on mission trips, as a religious education teacher, and served on many committees and as President and Treasurer of the Church Council. He volunteered as a Junior Achievement advisor. He was an active volunteer at his children's activities including serving as an Odyssey of the Mind coach and was ever present on the sideline for his grandchildren at their sporting events. He enjoyed reading, fishing, and being with his family most of all. He was a wonderful husband, father and grandfather and will be

deeply missed.
