



## Jack R. Astrike

May 17, 1932 - July 24, 2023

Jack R. Astrike, age 91, of Jasper, Indiana, passed away at 2:14 p.m. on Monday, July 24, 2023 at Amber Manor in Petersburg, Indiana.

Jack was born in Huntingburg, Indiana on May 17, 1932 to Albert and Alfrieda “Frieda” (Partenheimer) Astrike. He married June Nuhring on August 31, 1952, in Salem United Church of Christ in Huntingburg, Indiana and were married for 65 years. She preceded him in death on May 28, 2018.

He was a 1950 graduate of Huntingburg High School.

Jack served with the 45th Infantry Division Medical Detachment during the Korean War and was overseas for 16 months. He retired at 60 from Kimball International as Director of Procurement in 1992 after a 40-year career with the company.

He enjoyed hunting, gardening, horseshoes, home maintenance, woods, and trail walking, and traveling.

He was a member of Trinity United Church of Christ where he was Council President for two terms.
