James Richard Kent was born in Sullivan County, Indiana on June 26, 1926. He died at Davis Gardens of Westminster Village in Terre Haute, IN on December 9, 2009. His parents were Oris and Lucy Kent. He was predeceased by a sister Edna, and leaves an older brother Clifford in Santa Rosa, CA and a younger sister, Evelyn in Sullivan, IN. Several nieces and nephews will miss him.

Dick graduated from Fairbanks High School and joined the 82nd Airborne, serving in latter phases of World War 2 and in the Berlin Occupation. He graduated from Purdue University and received advance degrees from Virginia Tech- pursuing a career in statistics and quality assurance technology. In the Washington, DC Area he worked for BuTides and Parsons. Then he returned to Indiana to lead in computer applications to quality assurance programs for both military and civilian products at Crane NAD, Burns City, IN. There he met Armella; they married and lived in Jasper, IN, where he continued until moving to Westminster Village in Terre Haute in 1995. Armella predeceased him in 1988. Dick was a devout Christian. While in Jasper, he worshiped with the United Church of Christ; in Terre Haute with First Methodist. With later health limitations, he continued daily Bible meditations. May he rest in peace. Graveside services will be held at 11:00 a.m. Monday
