James C. "Jim" Gunselman, age 68 of Jasper, Indiana, passed away at 8:28 a.m. on Thursday, April 18, 2019 at St. Charles Health Campus in Jasper, Indiana.

Jim was born in Huntingburg, Indiana on August 18, 1950 to Clements J. and Anita (Schmidt) Gunselman. He married Belinda "Lindy" Zink on February 19, 1972 in St. Mary's Catholic Church in Huntingburg.

He was a graduate of the Huntingburg High School Class of 1968.

Jim retired as the Office Manager for Hoosier Bandag in Huntingburg after 40 years of service. He also was a co-founder of G-Crew L.L.C. in Jasper.
