



## James "Jim" W. Fischer

November 2, 1945 - July 23, 2018

James W. "Jim" Fischer, age 72 of Jasper, Indiana, passed away at 1:30 p.m. on Monday, July 23, 2018 at home.

Jim was born in Huntingburg, Indiana, on November 2, 1945 to Arthur J. and Lorene Rose (Blessinger) Fischer. He married Shirley Hopf on October 2, 1969 in Holy Family Catholic Church in Jasper.

He served in the Indiana Army National Guard, and was a member of the St. Anthony American Legion Post #493 where he served on the Honor Guard.

Jim retired from Kimball International after 39 years of service, and then worked for St. Vincent de Paul for 10 years. He served for 4 years on the Jasper City Council.

He was a member of Holy Family Catholic Church in Jasper, where he served as an usher and server, and was a member of their Holy Name Society. He was a member of the Jasper Knights of Columbus and the St. Anthony Conservation Club.
