Jeff E. Fleck, age 61, of Jasper, Indiana, passed away at 8:25 a.m. CDT on Friday, June 15, 2018 at St. Vincent Hospital in Evansville, Indiana, surrounded by his family.

Jeff was born on January 3, 1957 in Jasper, Indiana to Albert H. and LaVern C. (Sermersheim) Fleck.

Jeff had worked for SIRS in Ferdinand, and had also worked for the Jasper Knights of Columbus and other area restaurants.

He was an Eagle Scout with Troop #188 and was a Special Olympics athlete, winning numerous medals.

Jeff was a member of Holy Family Catholic Church in Jasper, the Jasper Knights of Columbus, and an associate member of the Fraternal Order of Police.

He enjoyed spending time with his friends and family at his residence in Jacob's Village in Evansville, collecting stuffed animals, and shrimp dinners.
