Dateline Jasper, Indiana Jerome J. Jochem, age 91 of Jasper, passed away at 11:20 a.m. Friday, (January 2, 2015), in St. Charles Health Campus in Jasper. He was born at St. Henry, Indiana on February 14, 1923 to Leo and Clara (Hohl) Jochem. He married Virginia Mehringer on September 9, 1947 in St. Joseph Catholic Church in Jasper. She preceded him in death on December 26, 1974. He was a 1941 Holland High School Graduate.

Jerome was a WW II U.S. Army Veteran serving in Germany under General Patton in the European Theatre. He retired from Masterbrand Cabinets where he worked in the maintenance department. He is a member of Precious Blood Catholic Church in Jasper. In 1998 he received the Diocese of Evansville Brut'e award in recognition of exemplary stewardship by the Most Rev. Gerald A Gettellfinger.
