Dateline Jasper: Jerome Schneider age 84 of Jasper passed away at 4:02 P.M. Thursday April 9, 2009 at Jasper Memorial Hospital. He was born March 30, 1925 at Jasper to: John and Mayme (Dudine) Schneider He married Doris Kremp July 19, 1951 Mr. Schneider attended the University of Notre Dame and graduated from California Institute of Technology, served in the U.S. Navy as a lieutenant in Civil Engineering Corps, taught Mathematics and Latin at Jasper High School, practiced as a Civil Engineer and Land Surveyer, was an entrepreneur with automatic car washes in Jasper, Huntingburg, and Evansville. Raised pure bred Arabian horses. He served 4 terms as Dubois County Surveyer and served 25 years on the Jasper City Planning Board serving as City Engineer and 25 years on the Jasper Chamber traffic committee. He was a member of the American Society of Civil Engineers, a member of St. Joseph Parish Council, a 4th Degree Member of the K of C, a member of the Holy Name Society, the Father Brute Society, Serra Club, Eucharistic Adoration Committee. The American Legion, Charter member and 2nd president of the Jasper Jaycees. Mr. Schneider was an Eagle Scout and a recipient of the Eddie Rottet Memorial Award.
