Jerry L. Musgrave, age 78, of Jasper, Indiana, passed away at 2:50 p.m. on Sunday, March 31, 2019, in the Northwood Retirement Community in Jasper, Indiana.

Jerry was born in Dale, Indiana, on June 8, 1940, to Leroy "Red" and Mary Mable (Wilkey) Musgrave. He married Eileen Beard on July 27, 1961, in Precious Blood Catholic Church in Jasper, Indiana.

He was a 1958 graduate of Dale High School.

He retired from Kimball International, where he had worked for 42 years. He then worked at Jasper Park and Recreation for 13 years.

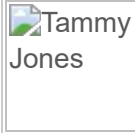
