Dateline Jasper, Indiana Joseph F. Casper, age 90 of Jasper passed away at 5:35 a.m. today (Tuesday, June 21, 2011) in the St. Charles Health Campus in Jasper. He was born in Jasper, Indiana on August 25, 1920 to Dr. Joseph F. and Marie (Kempf) Casper. He had two marriages; 1st to Mary Lou Eckerle in March 2, 1946, she died on May 7, 1970 ; 2nd marriage to Margaret Temple Berger on April 12, 1984. Joe Casper was a WW II Army Veteran .

He graduated from Jasper High School in 1938. After attending St. Joseph College for one year, he enrolled in the Louisville College of Pharmacy, graduating in 1943 when he entered the Army. After Basic Training he was sent to India, Burma, and China Theater. He flew the Hump and worked in the 259th Station Hospital in the Laboratory. He helped open a new Army Hospital in Kreiyang China where he ran the Pharmacy for the next two years. Upon discharge in 1946 he opened Casper's Drugs until 1965 when he went to Memorial Hospital as Manager of the Pharmacy. He left the hospital in 1980 doing relief work in area pharmacies until he retired in 1982. He was an avid Cubs fan and loved playing cards. He is a member of Holy Family Catholic Church – Jasper Knight's of Columbus, 4th Degree – V.F.W. Post # 673 and American Legion Post #147.
