Keith A. Kluesner, age 43 of Dubois, Indiana, passed away at 9:00 p.m. on Monday, December 23, 2024 at Deaconess Gateway Hospital in Newburgh, Indiana, surrounded by family.

Keith was born in Jasper, Indiana on June 24, 1981 to Ronald and Carol (Haas) Kluesner. He married Angela Blackgrove on July 25, 2020 at the Celestine Community Club.

He was a 2000 graduate of Northeast Dubois High School.

Keith worked as a foreman for the Dubois County Highway Department.

He was a 22-year member of the Dubois Volunteer Fire Department and was a first responder.
