He was born March 6, 1927 in Reeve Township , Daviess County Indiana to Thomas Ewing and Eva Gladys (Hershman) Arvin. He married Lea Anna Baker on November 21, 1948, she preceded him in death on may 10, 2007. Ajax Arvin was a WWII Army Veteran serving in the Army Signal Corps. He was a graduate of Alfordsville High School Class of 1944 and a graduate of Purdue University in 1956. Ajax Arvin worked at the Crane Naval Weapons Center as a comptroller for many years. Also worked for the Union Starch Cummings, Inc. and retired from Keating of Chicago where he was the Vice President of Accounting Department.
