Larry M. Jones, age 74 of Jasper, Indiana, passed away at 9:46 a.m. on Saturday, January 19, 2019 at the Linda E. White Hospice House in Evansville, Indiana.

Larry was born in Columbia, Missouri on March 31, 1944 to Marion A. and Beatrice E. (Arnold) Jones. He married Joetta L. Johanning on July 8, 1967 in Glasgow, Missouri.

Larry worked for over 20 years in Hospital Administration in Chicago and Jasper, and was owner of Printing Services Inc. in Jasper.

He was involved with the Jasper Jaycees and the Jasper Rotary Club, and was also involved in ministry with the Dubois County Community Corrections.
