Leroy J. Schnaus, age 95, of Ireland, Indiana, passed away at 4:03 p.m. on Sunday, May 14, 2017, at home.

Leroy was born in Ireland, Indiana, on September 11, 1921 to Albert and Cecelia (Dick) Schnaus. He married Dorothy M. Mehringer on October 19, 1946, in St. Joseph's Catholic Church in Jasper, Indiana.

Leroy was a lifetime farmer.

He was a member of St. Mary's Catholic Church in Ireland, the Ireland Historical Society, and he was a charter and 70 year member of the Ireland K of C, and a charter member of the Ireland Sportsman Club. He was a 30 year member of the Ireland Utilities Board, where he was an original member.

He was an avid sports fan, and especially enjoyed following the Jasper Wildcats, the Chicago Cubs, and Indiana University Basketball. He also enjoyed playing golf and cards, especially Sheephead.
