Dateline Jasper: Leslie "Les" Stallwood age 85 of Jasper passed away at 4:40 A.M. Saturday August 27, 2005 from complications of Alzheimer's disease at the Heritage House Nursing Center in Jasper. He was born August 22, 1920 in Farnborough England to: George and Minnie (Preece ) Stallwood. He immigrated to the United States with his family at the age of 5. After living briefly in Dayton Ohio the family set up permanent residence in Indianapolis. Les graduated from Manual High School and Purdue University with a degree in Mechanical Engineering.
