Lila Lee Seger, age 90, of Jasper, Indiana passed away at 1:10 a.m. on Wednesday (May 13, 2015) at home.

Lila was born in Jasper, Indiana on March 12, 1925, to Cyril "Snap" and Lucille (Krodel) Giesler. She married Jerome F. Seger on August 21, 1947 in St. Joseph's Catholic Church in Jasper. He preceded her in death on July 16, 2003.
