Liseta T. Buechler, age 88 of Jasper, Indiana, passed away at 1:15 a.m. on Saturday, January 4, 2020 at Northwood Retirement Community in Jasper, Indiana.

Liseta was born in Jasper, Indiana on Thanksgiving day, November 26, 1931 to Urban and Colette (Burger) Fuhs. She married Jacob G. "Jake" Buechler on May 26, 1951 in St. Joseph's Catholic Church in Jasper. He preceded her in death on January 21, 1994.

She attended St. Joseph Catholic Schools and worked as a cook and housekeeper for the St. Joseph Convent in Jasper with the Sisters of Providence for over 20 years. She also worked at the House of Yesteryear in Ferdinand.
