She enjoyed working in her flower beds and making angel food cakes and noodles. She had many requests for her tasty angel food cakes.

Surviving are her husband, Robert Taylor, Cannelburg, IN, one daughter, Debra Taylor, Cannelburg, IN, and one granddog, Rusty.

Preceding her in death are one sister, Dorothy Ziegler, and four brothers, Delbert, Linus, Carl, and Kenny Weisman.
