Louis F. "Louie" Lueken age 92 of Celestine, Indiana, passed away at 12:36 p.m. Wednesday, June 21, 2017, at St. Charles Health Campus in Jasper.

Louie was born in Schnellville, Indiana on May 4, 1925 to Leo and Bertha (Miller) Lueken. He married Irene Humbert on April 7, 1951 in St. Celestine Catholic Church. She preceded him in death on March 31, 2005.

Louie was a U.S. Army Veteran who served in WWII and is a member of the Jasper VFW Post #673.

He was a retired poultry farmer who worked for Ralph Seger Farms most of his life and also worked for Jasper Wood Products. He was a former member of the Marion Township Advisory Board and was one of the first members of the Dubois Fire Department Advisory Board.
