Dateline Celestine, Indiana Lowell E. Glendening age 80 of Celestine, Indiana died at 7:25 p.m. Monday (June 5, 2006) in the Memorial Hospital and Health Care Center in Jasper. He was born at North Lewisburg, Ohio on October 5, 1925 to Kenneth and Leona (Myers) Glendening. He married Joan D. Jerger (Whom he met in the Navy in WWII), on September 3, 1946 in St. Mary's Catholic Church, Ireland, IN, she preceded him in death on March 30, 2000. Lowell Glendening retired from the Old Dubois County Bank as an agricultural loan officer in 1984 – served in the U.S. Navy on two ships during WWII in the South Pacific. Following graduation from Purdue University in 1950 he served as Ass't County Agent in Gibson County and as County agent in Perry County. He also was commercial agronomist for the Mulzer Limestone Co., Tell City for federal Chemical Company in Illinois. He was active in many of the agricultural organizations in the county and area and helped organize the first 4-H County Council. In his retirement he helped start the Dubois County Tourism Commission and the Dubois County Museum. He was past Commander of the American Legion Post # 147 and the V.F.W. Post 673 in Jasper. Surviving is 1 daughter, Mrs. Scott " Elaine" Glendening Klag, Portland, OR
