She was born at Brazil IN. to: Clem and Anna Orr (Sharp) Browne. She was raised by her uncle and aunt Seph and Jess (Sharp) Inman in Linton IN. After graduating from Indiana State Teacher College (Indiana State University) she taught in the Linton City School system. During WW2 she was a payclerk at the Huntingburg Furniture Co. She married Fielding P. Williams Sr. MD August 8, 1935. He passed away in 1978.
