Lucille C. Doty, age 90, of Dubois, Indiana, passed away at 6:40 a.m. on Saturday, July 8, 2023, in St. Charles Health Campus in Jasper, Indiana.

Lucille was born in Dubois, Indiana, on June 20, 1933, to Albert and Helen (Seeger) Sander. She married Warren E. Doty on Oct. 1, 1955, in St. Raphael's Catholic Church in Dubois, IN. He preceded her in death on October 2, 1968.

She was a graduate of Dubois High School and then graduated from beauty college in Indianapolis, Indiana.

She was a beautician, child care provider, a foster mother for 23 children, and an elder care provider. She was also a dedicated mother and homemaker.
